Subject: Classes Resume

Yesterday, the Government of Alberta introduced Bill 2 – the Back to School Act in the Legislature. This legislation brings an end to the ongoing labour dispute between the Alberta Teachers' Association and the Government of Alberta and requires teachers to return to work.

As a result, classes across Alberta will resume on Wednesday, October 29, 2025. Prairie Land schools will reopen on that date, and we look forward to welcoming students and staff back to their schools and classrooms.

At this time, there has been no decision regarding the January Diploma or Provincial Achievement Test administrations, nor how lost instructional time will be made up. These are important matters for both families and staff, and we are hopeful that clear direction will be available soon. I anticipate being able to share more information about both items by the latter part of this week.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we prepare to return to normal school operations.
