Subject: Strike – October 6, 2025

The Alberta Teachers' Association (ATA) has voted to begin strike action starting **Monday**, **October 6**, **2025**, **at 12:01 a.m.** This decision comes as part of ongoing labour negotiations between the ATA and the Government of Alberta. As a result, all Prairie Land schools will be closed to students beginning that day.

What You Need to Know

- All classroom instruction will pause during the strike.
- Extracurricular activities and school events that require teachers will also be suspended.
- Other school staff will continue to receive direction from the division, but schools will remain closed to students until the strike is resolved.

A Word About Our Teachers

Our teachers are valued members of our school communities, and we recognize the important role they play in the lives of Prairie Land students. While the current labour dispute is between the ATA and the Government of Alberta, we want to acknowledge the professionalism and care our teachers continue to show for their students and communities.
